Marion's Producers and Consumers

Objective

Students will learn that a consumer is a person whose wants are satisfied by using goods and services. A producer makes goods and/or provides services. Students will learn about some of the producers in Marion County.

Learning target

I can describe the differences between producers and consumers.

Materials:

- Producers/Consumers Sort Mat
- Chart paper markers
- Scissors
- Glue or glue sticks

Vocabulary

producers, consumers, goods, services

Procedures

- 1. Explain to students that **goods** are something that you can use or consume. **Goods** are owned by the purchaser and can be used once or repeatedly. Goods are always tangible property. As a group, brainstorm a list of **goods** and chart them on chart paper.
- 2. Explain that **services** are actions or an action that someone does for you. **Services** are not tangible property. As a group, brainstorm a list of **services** and chart them on chart paper.
- 3. Explain that **producers** make goods and/or provide services, and a **consumer** is a person whose wants are satisfied by using **goods** and **services**. A **consumer** is a person whose wants and needs are satisfied by using **goods** and **services**.
- 4. Introduce the items on the Producers/Consumers Sort to the students. Discuss each item so that students clearly understand each item.
- 5. Allow students time to work with a partner to cut out each item and sort the items into two categories, **producers** and **consumers**.
- 6. Then, direct students to glue each item onto the sort mat in the appropriate category.
- 7. Regroup as a class, discuss students' answers.

Assessment

Teacher observation of class discussion. Students' completed sorts.


